Mike Lindell Presents New Evidence of Election Vulnerabilities

The United States of America came about through the efforts of individuals willing to put their lives, their fortunes, and their sacred honor on the line. Embattled businessman, **Mike Lindell**, has done just that since the 2020 elections.

“I’m an entrepreneur,” says Lindell. “DEI big retailers and other players have tried to put me out of business, simply because I ask questions and care about the integrity of our elections.”



Despite spending much of his fortune defending his skepticism of our nation's election security, Lindell doesn't plan to stop. On Thursday, April 18, he led an Election Round Table Event at the Ahern Hotel in Las Vegas, moderated by **Steve Bannon**.

With a team including attorneys **Kurt Olsen** and **Patrick McSweeney**, and elections experts **Clay Parikh** and **Col. John Mills**, Lindell laid out what he called "new evidence" of election interference, indicating the inherent vulnerability of election machines, including:

1. **Maricopa's software was altered.** This software has never been certified by the Secretary of State or the EAC. Maricopa has repeatedly and falsely represented that they're using EAC-certified software, but they're not.
2. **They did not perform statute-required logic and accuracy testing prior to the election.** This is supposed to be done to give the public confidence that these machines will accurately read and tabulate the ballots.
3. With respect to every Dominion we've seen in multiple states, **Dominion leaves in the election database decryption keys designed to un-encrypt data.** That's like saying we have the most secure bank vault in the world and then putting a post-it-note with the combination written on the outside of the vault! Even worse, key logging features that would record system activity showing such control can also be manipulated or disabled, thereby rendering any penetration of this system nearly undetectable.

Elections expert Clay Parikh said during the event that both Democrats and Republicans use machines to cheat, and that this issue of machine vulnerability is “We the People against the Uniparty!”

Parikh, who was hired by the voting system testing lab, Pro V&V from 2008-2017 to perform EAC certification testing, claims that voting system vulnerabilities are intentional. “Every IT pro who looks at these systems is shocked at how awful and sloppy they are; it can’t be accidental. It’s purposely done to confuse everything. There are a thousand ways in.”

According to Lindell, “An Obama-appointed judge expressed in the *Georgia Curling v. Raffensperger* case this spring that experts like **Alex Halderman** demonstrated that there are problems with the machines...The judge also indicated that questioning the machines does not make you a conspiracy theorist. So, I got to take off my tinfoil hat on national TV. Professor Halderman, with a ballpoint pen, had flipped the election right in front of that judge. Now that judge has to decide whether or not we continue to use the machines.”

“SCOTUS declined to hear the appeal of the *Lake v Fontes* case on April 22,” according to Lindell. “So our evidence will not be examined by them. However, the American people deserve to see it and the court of public opinion should take a fair look.”



“In any fight,” he says, “you win some battles and lose some battles, but we must win the war for secure elections...for *all* Americans!”

While *Lake v Fontes* will not get its day in the Supreme Court, the new evidence remains uncontested—the defense declined to answer the issues raised with SCOTUS.

Skepticism regarding the security of election machines persists like a hanging chad, and doubt over the security of election machines seems to be growing.

Rasmussen, long a skeptic of Lindell’s claims, [re-posted a 10-minute video on X](#) prior to the Las Vegas Round Table, with the post reading, “Fall of the Machines,” with the caption, “Three new blockbuster pieces of evidence supporting new SCOTUS filing to eliminate the use of electronic voting machines.”

“Regardless of court battles and claims of culpability, the fact could not be more clear: election machines can *easily* be hacked,” says Lindell. “We don’t have to go back to the 2020 or 2022 elections and undo what happened there. What we need to do is come together as Americans, admit there are vulnerabilities, and ensure that the 2024 elections are completely fair, transparent, and secure.”

Veteran Supreme Court attorney Patrick McSweeney gave a warning at the Las Vegas event: “The voters are not in control until we change how elections are conducted.”
